We had 22 campers. Gave out 5 scholarships.

Total Volunteer Hours 386.25 hours including our teen mentors, adults and garden team.

We had a surplus from 2018 of \$2,159.00.

Total Revenue for 2019 \$4,135.00

\$855.00 was scholarship.

Expenses were \$3,130.36 which covered scholarship, supplies, ads and teacher compensation.
